DESCRIPTION OF THE BLENDED INTENSIVE PROGRAM:

During the program, students will work on the following topics in international teams:

- From ancient Roman city to modern capital: challenges of preserving ancient heritage in a modern urban environment. Global and local aspects;
- Archaeological and cultural heritage in an urban environment as common human values. International interdisciplinary partnerships for the study and preservation of archaeological and cultural heritage in the future;
- Team interdisciplinary work for comprehensive documentation and work with cultural heritage assets;
- Capacity building of the participants through on-site skill development lectures and interactive laboratory sessions;
- Research on theoretical and field approaches in an urban environment;
- The importance and role of local communities in preserving cultural heritage;

The programme includes a lecture course, training workshops, presentations, group work, and field trips.

Number of credits to be earned upon successful completion of the course: 4 ECTS
